Bicycle and Pedestrian Infrastructure Impact Fee Ordinance

In accordance with 24 V.S.A. § 1972, the citizens of the Town of St. Albans are hereby notified that on September 3rd, 2019, the Selectboard adopted the Bicycle and Pedestrian Infrastructure Impact Fee Ordinance. The purpose for this ordinance is to improve bicyclist and pedestrian safety and better street usability which will better enhance the character of roads and the entire community.
